Principal's Report

Industrial Action

As you may be aware, the NSW Teacher's Federation have called upon its members to strike on Tuesday 7 December. As I write, we are ascertaining how many staff members will participate in this industrial action.

Further information will be sent tomorrow (Thursday) via Sentral/ Skoolbag and the class parent network that will outline the level of supervision that will be provided next Tuesday.

Confirmation of whether our scheduled Presentation Assemblies will proceed as planned (see below) will also be communicated.

Presentation assemblies

Our annual Presentation assemblies will take place on the following days during Week 10:

Stage 2 (Years 3 and 4) – Tuesday 7 December at 9.15am. (TBC via Sentral/Skoolbag)

Stage 3 (Years 5 and 6) – Tuesday 7 December at 11.15am. (TBC via Sentral/Skoolbag)

Stage 1 (Years 1 and 2) – Wednesday 8 December at 9.15am.

Early Stage 1 (Kindergarten) – Wednesday 8 December at 11.15am.

Owing to the current restrictions, each of our Presentation

assemblies will be held without a parent audience in attendance. Each assembly will be recorded, and links made available (via Seesaw) to parents of students who have received an award. Students will also be able to watch the recording of their cohort's assembly.

Level 3 Settings

We continue to remain at Level 3 settings and these settings will be in place for the final three weeks of the year. We are unfortunately unable to allow parents on-site to attend our Presentation assemblies, Year 6 Farewell, Year 6 Graduation assembly or Year 6 Clap out. Each of these activities will occur but will be modified to comply with health guidelines.

Each Presentation assembly will be recorded, and links shared via Seesaw for parents of students receiving an award to view. All students will be able to watch a recording of their assembly in class.

The Year 6 Farewell will be held on the evening of Wednesday 15 December. Whilst we are unable to have parents on-site, we will offer parents the opportunity to take photos outside the school gates as students arrive, ensuring that social distancing is maintained.

The Year 6 Graduation assembly will be held on the morning of Thursday 16 December. Our plan is to hold this assembly outdoors so that all Year 6 students can attend at the same time, but we are unable to allow parents onsite to attend. The assembly will be recorded, and links shared with all Year 6 parents. This plan is highly weather dependent and will change if it is raining (or threatening to rain) on the day.

The traditional Year 6 Clap out will occur but in a different format to previous years to ensure that we do not allow different student cohorts to mix. Again, parents are unable to come onsite to view the clap out, but a recording will be made available for Year 6 parents.

Planning for 2022

We are busily planning in preparation for next year. In order to allow us to plan as effectively as possible, we ask families who know that they won't be returning to the school next year, to write to us as soon as possible. Similarly, if you are aware that your child will return to our school after 1 February 2022 due to an extended holiday or other reason, I ask that you write to us to confirm these details as well.

I have included a slip in the newsletter for you to complete and send back to the front office if either of these scenarios apply to you. Thank you for your anticipated co-operation with this matter.

Teachers are currently working on forming 2022 classes. Should you have a specific request with regard to your child's class placement next year, I ask that you put that request in writing to me via email at craig.oliver@det.nsw.edu.au.

Attendance

All students should be in attendance at school, unless:

- they have a medical certificate which says they can't return to school due to a condition or illness;
- they are currently unwell;
- they have been asked by NSW Health to self-isolate.

Any person with any COVID-19 symptoms will be sent home and should not return to school unless:

- they have isolated for 10 days, when no medical certificate is available;
- they have a negative COVID-19 test result and are symptom free;
- In circumstances where children have other medical reasons for recurrent symptoms, a letter from their GP is sufficient to negate the requirement for a negative test.

Join The Band

Dear Parents,

Enrolments are now open to students who wish to join the school band in 2022. See below for a basic overview of the program.

Band Program Structure

Rehearsal: students work together in a full band setting, generally before or after school (30-60min each week)

Tuition: students work in small groups at school to learn new skills, usually on the same day as rehearsal (30min each week)

Students attend both rehearsal and tuition (weekly) at school.

Regular **practise** at home (3-4 times a week) is essential.

Band Program Costs

Tuition Fees: small group tuition and band rehearsal costs \$195 (plus a \$10 resource levy) per term. Individual tuition costs extra and is not available at all schools.

Instrument: students require their own instrument. TSA sells quality new instruments or offers 'rent-to-buy' starting at \$43 per month.

Accessories: students are provided with a workbook on enrolment but may require other accessories, generally less than \$50 per year.
