Partners in Learning (Tell Them From Me) – Parent Survey

The Partners in Learning parent survey is part of the Tell Them From Me suite of surveys on student engagement and wellbeing. The parent survey helps to clarify and strengthen the important relationship between parent and school. Participation in the parent survey is optional.

What does it ask?

The parent survey asks parents/carers a range of questions related to the following drivers of student outcomes:

- parents feel welcome
- parents are informed
- parents support learning at home
- parents' participation at school
- school supports positive behaviour
- safety
- inclusion
- school supports learning.

How do parents access the survey?

- Parents will be provided with a unique URL to log into the survey. This will be sent through SchoolBytes.
- The survey can be completed on a computer, tablet or mobile device and is available in 23 community languages.

Week 2 - Wednesday 23 October and Thursday 24 October

Students complete the expression of interest, during lunchtime on Wednesday (boys) and Thursday (girls).

Week 3 – Wednesday 30 October

Students prepare a short (one sentence) statement in Room 12, 11:50am-12:50pm (Wednesday). They then present this statement to all Year 5 students, Year 6 student leaders and Year 5 teachers (Rooms 13/14) on Wednesday 30 October (afternoon session). Students bring a pen/pencil as voting will take place.

Week 3 – Friday 1 November

Ballots are counted and the 'Top 12' boys and girls are identified. Candidates are informed at 9:00am on Friday 1 November. Year 5 students are informed of the outcome at lunchtime. Students will be issued with the poster guidelines (for the display cabinet).

Week 4 - Monday 4 November

Nominees are introduced to Years 2-5 students via PowerPoint. Each Year 2-5 class is issued with 'Top 12' poster to display in their class. Student posters are displayed in display cabinets.

Week 4 – Wednesday 6 November

All candidates plan and compose their speech from 11:20am-12:20pm, in Room 12 (5D). They will present their speech to the Year 5 students in Rooms 13/14 1:30-3:00pm. A video recording of each speech will be made. Year 5 students will vote after each set of candidates.

Week 5 – from Monday 11 November

Years 2 to 4 students will view the recordings of the speeches and will vote in their classes. Votes must be returned by Wednesday 13 November.

Week 5 - Thursday 14 November

The 'Top 6' girl and boy candidates are informed of their selection at recess.

Week 7 - (week beginning) Monday 25 November

'Top 6' boys and 'Top 6' girls are introduced to Years 2-5 classes, via a PowerPoint. Class teachers are to share this with their class that week.

Week 9 - Monday 9 December

Stage 3 Presentation Assembly - 2025 student leaders are announced. Leaders are also introduced to students at subsequent stage presentation assemblies.

School News

School Swimming and Water Safety Program

Applications for Year 2 students to participate in the School Swimming and Water Safety Program closed on School Bytes on Friday 27 September. Students with permission will participate in the program from Monday 28 October to Friday 8 November 2024 at Castle Hill Fitness and Aquatic Centre - 77 Castle St, Castle Hill. Each daily lesson is 40 minutes and will occur during school hours. Instruction will take place in the indoor pool. Students attending must be able to dry themselves, dress in school uniform and pack their bags. Payments are now due. We kindly request parents to finalise payments prior to the commencement of the program otherwise your child may not be eligible to participate.

All participating students have now received a printed out grading form, and an information note about the program. The grading form is doubled-sided (2 pages). A completed grading form is a requirement for your child to participate in the School Swimming and Water Safety Program. Grading forms must be completed and returned to your child's classroom teacher by Friday 18 October 2024.
