Organisation for 2025

Our planning for next year is well advanced. Thank you to everyone who has responded to our requests throughout the term and informed us if your child will be leaving our school at the end of this year or will be returning at some point after the first day of school. It makes a huge difference!

We would like parents to be aware that 2025 classes will not be formed on the first day of school next year. All students (K-6) will return to school on Thursday 6 February and remain in their 2024 class for at least the first couple of days until we are confident of our total enrolment numbers. This is due to the uncertainty as to how many new enrolments we will welcome to Castle Hill PS over the Christmas vacation.

Students starting in Kindergarten next year will receive further information before the end of next week. Over the holiday break and once the new building is handed over to us, we will make decisions regarding where students will line up on 9.00am of the first morning back at school. Regardless of the location, Year 1-6 students will line up in their 2024 classes. Please ensure that you have access to the **School Bytes app** to ensure you are updated with this information.

Year 6 Graduation Assembly and 'Clapout'

Next Wednesday morning, 18 December, we will farewell our Year 6 students in style by holding our annual Graduation Assembly at Castle Hill High School hall. We ask that parents and students arrive at 9.30am for a 10.00am start. 

Changes to the application process for 2026 - Opportunity Class (OC) and Selective High School

A reminder to all families in Year 3 and Year 5, that the application for Opportunity Class and Selective High School are open. Information was emailed to families in November. Parents wishing for their child to sit either exam, are asked to read the information contained in the email carefully and to pose any questions to Miss Machuca.

A reminder that a parent information session will be held on February 10, 2025, to discuss the assessments and to answer any questions. A time will be communicated before the end of the term.

Parents can also find some key dates below:

Key dates – applying for entry in 2026

- 7 November 2024 to 21 February 2025 parents and carers apply for selective high school or opportunity class entry in 2026.
- 2-4 May 2025 students sit the selective high school or opportunity class placement test for entry in 2026.
- 19 May 2025 make up test date (approved illness/misadventure requests)
- Term 3, 2025 placement outcomes and offers released to parents and carers
- Term 1, 2026 students who gain entry begin attending their opportunity class or selective high school
