Lunch Order Delivery

- Lunch must be ordered online or over the counter prior to 9:00am.
 Online ordering is preferred.
- Food is prepared and cooked during the day and packed into a lunch basket for each class ready for collection at their appointed lunchtime
- Lunch baskets are collected from the canteen windows by students from each class who are sent in pairs
- Lunches are distributed to the students in their classroom by their teachers
- Smaller children are supervised whilst eating in their designated eating area.
